





How it works

Encoded Media provides a suite of software and hardware components that work together as an end-to-end solution, or individually to add value to your existing video systems.

The suite enables anyone to make videos - when and where they want. Department heads can record regular updates from their offices or on the go using just their mobile or tablet. Executives can broadcast townhall events live to the entire company or across the world. Field engineers can send off-site videos back to the office from their smartphone.







Consolidate your existing and new videos in one central location, which viewers can access via a web portal or your Intranet or Internet site. Access to content can be controlled through Active Directory permissions, and user activity can be tracked, logged and reported.


Create and manage content

Encoded Media technology gives you direct control of your company's video resources, from the creation stage right through to distribution to viewers.


Use it to capture events such as conferences, training and company announcements, complete with accompanying slides. The software also provides easy-to-use editing tools to trim videos or extract key sections.

You can stream videos to staff no matter where they are, so no one misses out on key events.

Video Publisher enables users within your organisation to record and publish new videos directly from any desktop computer, meeting room or mobile device. Its one touch interface simplifies the task of video creation, streaming and content



management, and requires no technical knowledge to use.



Once recorded, content can be tagged, topped and tailed, embargoed and more.

Staff from different departments can create their own content, attach slides, tag keywords, add transcripts or subtitles, manage their own videos, and upload them to the company's video portal. Videos can be shared with everyone, or access can be limited to certain users or groups.



View live or on demand

Never miss out on a presentation or company event again. Encoded Media's products ensure you are able to stream them live, or watch later at a time that suits you.

With Encoded Media's platform, anyone can record important events and deliver them, together with the accompanying slide show, across private networks or the Internet.

As a viewer, you can access your organisation's online video catalogue through a familiar web portal and watch videos on your PC, TV screen or mobile.

Content can be categorised and indexed in a number of different ways, allowing you to browse or search quickly through the largest of libraries.

In addition, free text searching means you can quickly locate the content that's most relevant to you.





You can even find words mentioned in attached slides, and download any documents, handouts and transcripts that were part of the original event.

Slides aren't limited to Microsoft PowerPoint, but can be captured from any application, making it an ideal platform for both training and demonstrations.

You can also personalise the portal's appearance to look and feel the way you want it to, helping strengthen your organisation's branding.




Distribute content to anyone, anywhere

Your content can be distributed to everyone in your organisation with Video Library, no matter where they are located.

A key feature of Video Library is that it can overcome the limitations of busy company networks by sending copies of your videos to remote locations during quiet periods (e.g. overnight or at weekends). Remote users are automatically redirected to their local copy — completely avoiding the Wide Area Network (WAN).

Video Library can also be used as a way of delivering the very large files associated with High Definition (HD) recordings, making it possible to deliver broadcast-quality video across the slowest Internet connection.





Recording Appliances

Our range of hardware recorders for meeting rooms and auditoriums includes rack-mountable Linux appliances which automate the HD recording of auditoriums, lecture theatres, meeting rooms and more.

The HD Encoder range supports up to eight simultaneous video inputs, and can be operated via a user friendly web interface or via IP room automation (e.g. Creston, AMX).

Captured video can be broadcast live to any number of people on the network, with the integrated multi audience transcoding engine delivering the most appropriate stream to mobile and remote users.

Videos can also be saved to the HD Encoder's onboard storage, then automatically copied to a secure network folder once the recording has finished.



The HD Encoder can be useful in a number of different scenarios, including:

Single Camera

Record, stream and store a single video input.

Video and Slide Content


Simultaneously capture both presenter and presentation.

Case study

CHARLES STANLEY

Charles Stanley & Co. Ltd. are one of the UK's largest independently owned, full service stockbrokers. The head office is in London, and the company has over 40 branch offices around the UK.

The problem

Stockbrokers, like lawyers and other knowledge workers, receive regular Continuing Professional Development (CPD) training to maintain their skills and to this end Charles Stanley organises monthly training sessions in London. Brokers attend these sessions to keep up to date and gain CPD accreditation.

These sessions were recorded onto DVDs that were posted to the brokers based in the branch offices. With brokers distributed nationwide, distributing the DVDs was a challenge. DVD recordings were regularly lost in transit and keeping track of hundreds of discs at each office meant it was exceedingly difficult to know who was watching what.

The solution

Encoded Media provided Charles Stanley with a complete content distribution system which encodes the training sessions in London, along with supporting slides, and then delivers the content to branch offices overnight using their own WAN. This saves on time, postage and packaging costs and there is no longer a need to purchase, burn and keep track of physical DVDs.

Brokers are free to watch the training sessions when it's convenient for them. In addition to this, Encoded Media's TV Server product delivers live news channels to brokers to keep them informed of world events. Detailed usage tracking records who has watched what,

helping users stay on top of the training requirements and providing proof to their compliance team that they are up to date.




